

Unintentional and preventable injuries are the leading cause of death and disability to North Carolina children through age 14. Each year, 1 in 4 North Carolina children will be injured seriously enough to require medical attention.

Did You Know ?

Injuries are the 2nd leading cause of hospitalization & the leading cause of emergency room visits among children under age 14.



The annual cost of child injury deaths in United States is an estimated \$34.5 billion (US dollars).

- Each year approximately 1,800 children ages 14 and under are killed as occupants in motor vehicles, & more than 280,000 are injured.
- A correctly installed & used child ٠ safety seat reduces the risk of death by 71% for infants. However, it is estimated that the majority (approx. 82%) of children who are placed in child safety seats are improperly restrained.



Drowning is a guick and silent killer. In the time it takes to: ... cross the room for a towel (10 sec.). a child in the bathtub can become submerged.



answer the phone (2 min.), that Schild can lose consciousness.

sign for a package at your front door (4-6 min.), a child submerged in the bathtub or pool can sustain permanent brain damage.



Unfortunately, bicycles are more than a toy; they are associated with more childhood injuries than any consumer product except the automobile. In 2001, 134 children ages 14 and under died in bicycle-related crashes and in 2002, more than 288,000 were treated in hospital emergency rooms for bicycle-related injuries.



Nearly two-thirds of firearmowning parents with school-age children believe they keep their firearm safely away from their children. However, one study found that when a gun was in the home, 75-80% of 1st & 2nd graders knew where it was kept.

- Few children under age 8 can reliably distinguish between real & toy guns or fully understand the consequences of their actions. Yet children as young as age 3 are strong enough to pull the trigger of many handguns.
- Despite a dramatic 56% decline in the fire death rate since the Safe Kids program began in 1998, fires remain a leading cause of unintentional injury-related death among children in the United States.
