# SAFE KIDS DIVERSION CLASS

#### WHAT IS DIVERSION?

Drivers who are cited by law enforcement officers for child passenger safety violations will be given the gne-time opportunity to participate in this program including a class to learn the importance of child passenger safety and an appointment to ensure their child/ten/'s restraint is properly installed. After successful completion of the program participants will receive documentation to bring to the court to determine if the ticket will be vasible.

#### **CLASS DETAILS**

- Class is typically the 3rd Wednesday of the month from 9.30am - 10.30am
- Participants <u>must</u> call to register and pay a \$25 fee no later than the Monday prior to each class
- Participants must bring to class: citation, photo ID, child passenger safety restraint, child's height/weight
- Participants may be required to return at a later date for any follow-up corrections
