It is a simple, kind, strength-based, commonsense and effective four step process embodied in the FLIP IT mnemonic: F - Feelings, L - Limits, I - Inquiries, and P - Prompts. FLIP IT transforms best practice into a strategy that is easy to remember, applicable in a variety of challenging situations and portable. FLIP IT may not be rocket science, but it <i>is</i> brain development, and an effective strategy all teachers should know how to use. Come learn how to FLIP your kids instead of flipping your lid!
