National Fire Safety Prevention Week Oct. 6-12



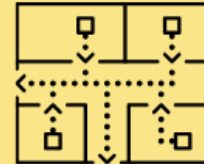
Every day at least one child dies in a home fire. And every day, 293 children are injured by fire and burns.

Home fires account for nearly 90% of all fire-related fatalities.



Working smoke alarms reduce the change of dying in a home fire **by half.**

77% of families have not developed and practiced a home fire escape plan, one of the most important components to surviving a home fire



Fire can spread rapidly through the home, leaving a family as little as 2 minutes to escape safely once the alarm sounds.
